PURPOSE:

In order to make maximum use of seismic margins methodologies (NRC and EPRI) in the implementation of the severe accident policy statement (Individual Plant Evaluations for External Events or IPEEE), several issues have arisen which may require extensions to the original methodologies. These changes are being considered because the seismic margins program was developed primarily to determine whether changes in the seismic hazard can be accommodated within the inherent capacity of the original design or whether plant modificat. ins are necessary. The severe accident policy statement is focused on beyond design basis events and the identification of plant specific vulnerabilities.

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The purpose of the meeting is to have the seismic subcommittee of the External Events Steering Group meet knowledgable consultants who are familiar in the development and application of the seismic martins methodologies in order to discuss the capability of the existing methods to address the needs posed by IPEEE and the feasibility of extending these methods to better meet these needs.
