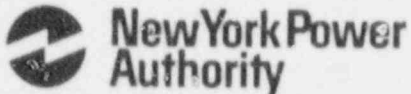

Regarding Crescent Area Ventilation (JPTS-86-010)

Dear Sir:

This application for an amendment to the James A. FitzPatrick Technical Specifications proposes changes regarding crescent area ventilation operability and surveillance testing.

Specifically, this change clarifies the term "compartment" in Specification 3.11.B.1 on page 239. Also, the change eliminates the conflict between Specifications 3.11.B.1 and 4.11.B.1. The current Specifications are unclear whether inoperability of more than one unit cooler per side results in a 7 day or 24 hour Limiting Condition for Operation.

Enclosed for filing is the signed original of a document entitled "Application for Amendment to Operating License", together with Attachments I and II thereto, comprising a statement of the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications and the associated Safety Evaluation.


