Enclosed please find "Revised ~~Draft~~ Regulations to Implement ~~Anticipated~~ Legislation on (1) Temporary Operating Authority and (2) No Significant Hazards Consideration (the 'Sholly Amendment')." The conferees have agreed on final language and the legislation is now pending. It would, among other things, authorize the NRC to (1) issue temporary operating licenses and (2) issue requested operating license amendments, involving no significant hazards consideration, before the conduct of any hearing. ~~This draft will be made final as soon as the legislation is enacted and the Commission's rules, SECY-81-366A (August 28, 1981), which contained the previous draft regulations, and is now pending before the Commission.~~

~~This draft will be circulated for review to the Director of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, the General Counsel, and the Chairman of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board and the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel.~~ *has written a memorandum to me which is included as Enclosure 10 of the package.*
