SUBJECT: LICENSE AMENDMENTS INVOLVING NO SIGNIFICANT
HAZARDS CONSIDERATION

Enclosed is a marked up copy of the document amending Parts 2 and 50 concerning license amendments involving no significant hazards consideration.

The material in this document must be divided into two documents to separate the final rule from the proposed rule. The Office of the Federal Register will not accept a document for publication in the Federal Register if it combines material that must appear under more than one publication category (1 CFR 18.2).

The publication of the two documents may be coordinated so that they would appear in the same separate part of a Federal Register issue. Appropriate cross-references could be inserted to "connect" the two documents. Finally the largest portion of the statement of consideration could appear in the lead document, in this case the final rule, and the portion relevant only to the proposed provisions would appear in the proposed rule.

I have separated the one document into a final rule document and a proposed rule document. I have also included the cross-references necessary to bridge the documents. Note that each document must be a complete package including -

- The preamble format
- Paperwork and Regulatory Flexibility statements
- Authority citations
- Signature

If the new legislation must be reflected in the authority citations for Part 2 or 50, the amendment must be presented in the form of a complete revision to the authority for those parts.
