Thank you for your responses of August 11 and August 29, 1988, to our Emergency Operating Procedures (EOPs) Inspection Report No. 88-09 dated June 8, 1988, concerning activities conducted at your Crystal River facility. We have evaluated your responses and found that they are acceptable pending onsite inspector follow-up review. We will examine the implementation of your corrective actions during future inspections, especially with regard to identification and elimination of potential programmatic weaknesses.

As noted in the inspection report, and reemphasized during our telephone conversation of August 18, 1988, you are encouraged to pursue the development of vendor generic procedural guidelines with the Owners Group. Your development of those vendor generic procedural guidelines should provide a clearer understanding of the technical bases for differences between the Crystal River Abnormal Transients Operating Guidelines and Emergency Operating Procedures. We feel this development is necessary to preserve the accident mitigation strategy of the ATOG bases document.
