Reference (a) incorrectly documents the explicit commitment we made in Reference (b), which was our understanding of the agreements reached during Reference (c).

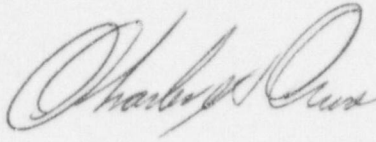
Our plan regarding further actions to address the Unit 2 pressurizer instrument nozzle weld flaw is as follows:
