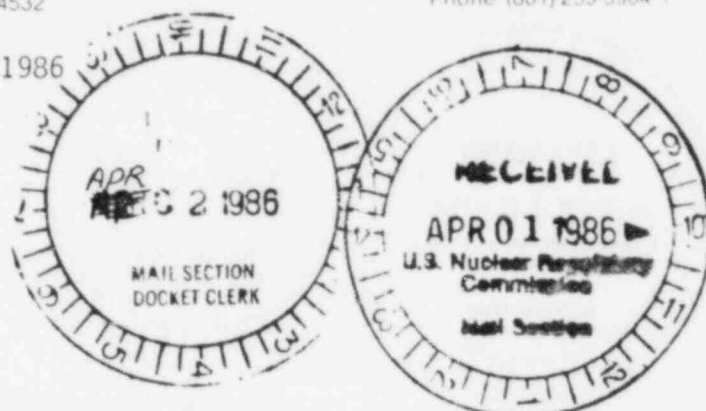

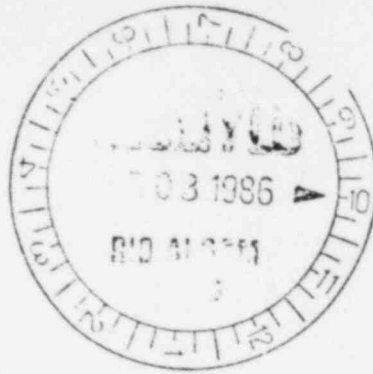

Attached are the results of the ALARA Audit conducted on January 27 and 28, 1986. The radiation safety program is being conducted in a safe manner and is consistent with the ALARA philosophy. With the exception of some minor recommendations included in the body of the report, the only recommendation is that procedures related to the license and radiation safety be reviewed, updated as necessary and combined into one manual.
