Dear Mr. Bearden:

In accordance with the telephone conversations on September 17 and 29, 1988, between you and your staff and Ms. Vivian Carlton and Dr. Dale A. Powers of our staff, we understand that you, as President of Eagle Inspection and Testing, Inc., have placed the corporation in an inactive status. It is further our understanding that the corporation currently has no licensed material, but may obtain licensed material in the future. We were told that mail sent to Eagle Inspection and Testing, Inc. should be addressed in care of Eagle International Testing. We understand that you are also President of Eagle International Testing, which is a company licensed to possess radioactive material by the state of Louisiana.

We were informed that Eagle Inspection and Testing, Inc. has not received a copy of NRC Bulletin No. 88-06 dated June 14, 1988, concerning "Actions to be Taken for the Transportation of Model No. SPEC 2-T Radiographic Exposure Device." A copy of the bulletin is enclosed.

Please provide a response for Eagle Inspection and Testing, Inc. as directed by the bulletin to this office within 10 days of receipt of this letter.
