(but excluding documents included on Docket No. 50-293 accession listings available from the Public Document Room) of NRC Region I, the Office of the Executive Director for Operations, the Office of Inspection and Enforcement, the Office of Investigations, the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, the Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards, the Advisory Committee for Reactor Safeguards, the Office for Evaluation of Operational Data, and the NRC Emergency Operations Center which discuss, refer to, take positions on, or form the basis for decisions concerning, the performance of the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station in the following areas:
