Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Sir:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act, as amended, 5 U.S.C. § 552. On behalf of the San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace -- intervenors in the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant ("Diablo Canyon") licensing proceeding (In the Matter of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Nos. 50-275, 323) -- I am writing to request a copy of the Diablo Canyon Long-Term Seismic Program Final Report (July 1988).

If you determine that any portion of the document is exempt from release, please advise me as to which exemption(s) you believe covers the materials that you are not releasing and the reasons supporting that belief. In addition, the Act requires that you provide me with the remaining non-exempt portions. I reserve the right to appeal any decision to withhold information and expect that you will list the address and office to which such an appeal may be directed.

As you know, the amended Act permits you to reduce or waive search and copying fees if it "is in the public interest primarily benefiting the public." 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A). Because the Center for Law in the Public Interest is a non-profit institution, because the San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace is a citizen organization that has been an active intervenor in the Diablo Canyon proceedings


