"Critical areas" for traffic control include Plum Island Turnpike, Rolfe's Lane, Hanover Street, the intersection of Parker Street and Route 1, High Road, Hay Street, the intersection of Route 1 and Boston Road, the intersection of Route 1A and Hay Street, the intersection of Highfield Road and Scotland Road, Central Street and the entrances to Triton Regional High School and Governor Dummer Academy.


Unidentified nursery schools and day care facilities include Creative Playhouse and Children's Treasure House in Byfield and a day care facility located at 20 Green Street in Byfield.

"Inadequate equipment and personnel": TON does not have and is unlikely to acquire a sufficient number of personnel to maintain traffic flow and two-way traffic on evacuation routes or the critical areas identified above. TON does not have and is unlikely to acquire sufficient equipment, e.g. cones or barricades, to maintain such traffic flows. TON does not have and is unlikely to acquire equipment which will enable it to maintain the passability of roads which become impassable due to weather or flooding. TON agrees to supplement this portion of this supplemental answer upon more specific request or clarification from Applicant as to the facts being sought.


