SUBJECT: STAFF SAFETY EVALUATION FOR ITEM 1.2 OF GENERIC LETTER 83-28

The Philadelphia Electric Company was requested in Generic Letter 83-28, "Required Actions Based on Generic Implications of Salem ATWS Events" to describe its post-trip review program. The post-trip review action item consisted of Action Item 1.1, "Program Description and Procedure" and Action Item 1.2, "Data and Information Capability." The safety evaluation for Item 1.1 was included in Supplement No. 5 to the SER in July 1985. The safety evaluation enclosed with this letter addresses Item 1.2.

The staff has completed its review of your response in letters dated November 10, 1983 and August 31, 1984, and concludes that the post-trip review data and information capability for the Limerick Generating Station is acceptable.

The enclosed safety evaluation is provided for your information. No response is required to this letter.
