NRC STAFF RESPONSE TO LILCO MOTION
FOR LEAVE TO EXCEED PAGE LIMIT

The Staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission hereby responds to and supports Long Island Lighting Company's (LILCO) October 5, 1988 motion for leave to extend the page limit on its Petition for Review of ALAB-901 and Follow-On Orders.

LILCO has indicated that each of the Appeal Board issuances for which review is sought, ALAB-901, the Order of September 27, 1988 and the Memorandum and Order of September 29, 1988 is a separate "decision or action" within the meaning of 10 C.F.R. 2.786(b). As such, each would be entitled to a petition of up to ten pages. Since these decisions and actions are interrelated, LILCO's combined petition of sixteen pages is a reasonable and efficient means of presenting the issues. Moreover, part of the petition consists of background material that, while not strictly required, would be very helpful in ruling on the petition.

For the above reasons the Staff supports LILCO's motion, and requests that the other parties be allowed a similar extension of the page limit (up to a total of 20 pages) if the motion is granted.
