By letter dated May 20, 1998, the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) transmitted changes to the Emergency Plan for the USGS TRIGA Reactor Facility under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(q). In response to requests for additional information from the NRC staff, modifications to the plan were submitted by letters dated July 29, and September 15, 1998. The plan was reviewed using NUREG-0849, "Standard Review Plan for the Review and Evaluation of Emergency Plans for Research and Test Reactors." Your revised emergency plan submitted by letter dated May 20, 1998, as supplemented on July 29, and September 15, 1998, has been reviewed and found to be responsive to our questions and concerns.
