MOTION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS ATTORNEY GENERAL,
NEW ENGLAND COALITION ON NUCLEAR POLLUTION,
SEACOAST ANTI-POLLUTION LEAGUE AND TOWN OF HAMPTON
TO EXTEND TIME WITHIN WHICH TO REPLY TO THE NRC STAFF
AND APPLICANTS RESPONSES TO THE EXERCISE CONTENTIONS

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.711, the Massachusetts
Attorney General, New England Coalition on Nuclear Pollution,
