No expert or other witnesses have yet been selected to testify on this contention.

Information requested by the Applicants pertaining to the bus companies which will not participate and/or which have not provided reasonable assurance of participation has been supplied to the Applicants.

Preliminary inquiries of schools have indicated that there are more students than have been estimated. The Mass. AG is presently investigating the current population count of schools, day care duties and nurseries.

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
