In References (a) and (b) Commonwealth Edison (ComEd) Company provided several commitments that had been implemented to avoid further violations. One of those commitments required, "... all non-editorial procedure changes to be reviewed by the Plant Operations Review Committee (PORC), unless specifically exempted or delegated."


ComEd has determined that since the quality of revisions to plant procedures has improved, PORC no longer needs to review, "... all non-editorial procedure changes," as committed in References (a) and (b). Eliminating the need to review all non-editorial procedure changes will allow PORC resources to focus on safety significant issues, therefore, providing for improvements in PORC effectiveness. The Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station PORC, however, will continue to review procedures required by NSP-AP-1002, "Plant Operations Review Committee," and as implemented by QCAP 1100-04, "Procedure Revision, Review and Approval." These administrative procedures require PORC reviews consistent with the requirements of the Quality Assurance Program Topical Report CE-1-A.
