

3. The Revision which is sought to be withheld from public disclosure contains details relating to the Physical Security Plans for Limerick Generating Station;

The information set forth in the Revision has been treated as confidential and proprietary information and has been withheld from public disclosure by Licensee in accordance with Licensee's practice of treating all information dealing with the details of security plans as confidential and proprietary information, and;


5. The Revision should be considered by the NRC as confidential and proprietary information and be withheld from public disclosure on the grounds that it contains Safeguards Information, it contains details relating to the physical security plans of a licensed facility, it contains detailed

information which could be used to compromise the safety and security of the facility, such disclosure is not required in the public interest and such disclosure would adversely affect the interests of Philadelphia Electric Company.
