At the scheduled October 14 meeting, the Commission will consider the staff's evaluations and recommendations concerning the restart of Pilgrim.

Any restart decision will be based on the judgement of the adequacy of the plant, the management, and the off-site emergency planning, and upon our overall judgement whether the Pilgrim plant can and will be operated safely.
