SR 5.0 and SR 5.2.1

Dear Mr. Calvo:

This letter submits proposed changes to the Fort St. Vrain Technical Specifications, SR 5.0 and SR 5.2.1. The change to SR 5.2.1, "PCRV and PCRV Penetration Overpressure Protection Surveillance," reflects the NRC's request that the test of the safety valves be in accordance with applicable ASME Code requirements, which includes the flexibility of valve testing either in place or on the bench.

The change to SR 5.0, "Surveillance Requirements," will add a new ISI Criterion to explain implementation requirements, which will allow an orderly transition to the new surveillance schedule.

A summary of the proposed changes is provided in Attachment 1, and the changes themselves are provided in Attachment 2. Attachment 3 contains the Significant Hazards Consideration for the proposed changes.

In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 170, an application fee of \$150.00 is enclosed.




