COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE  
UCLA SECURITY PLAN

At Section D.1. of the plan you state that only one member of the UCLA Police Department will immediately respond to an intrusion alarm and that additional personnel would be available to respond if needed. Your Security Plan, dated August 21, 1974, stated that at least two members of the security force would immediately respond. We find this change tends to decrease the effectiveness of the security plan for the facility. No explanation is offered for the change, and it appears that no compensating security measures have been provided. We request, therefore, that you provide justification for this proposed change or revise your plan to reflect the previously approved level of protection.
