The wrong UN 2974 number was used for QCI transporting vehicle to and from job site and was never involved in an accident or incident or submitted to any Agency other than QCI record keeping file.

All records of QCI's receiving or transferring Radioactive Materials, the correct special Form NOS 7 UN 2916 was used.

Corrective Actions for above Violations:

On May 7, 2020, QCI's Transportation Log Form Document Line Item corrected to UN 2916.

Reply to Notice of Violation 49CFR 172.203 (d) (3)

QCI's interpretation of 49CFR 172.203 – The activity may also be stated in an appropriate customary Unity (Curries) – meaning suitable or proper in the circumstances in lieu of international units (Becquerels).

Corrective Actions for above Violation:

As of May 9, 2020, QCI will report maximum activity in both Becquerels and Curies on QCI Transport Document.
