SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT Docket No. 71-9035 Model No. 680-OP Transport Package Certificate of Compliance No. 9035 Revision No. 24

SUMMARY

By application dated May 6, 2020 [Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML20128J291], QSA Global (the applicant) requested the extension of Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 9035, for the Model No. 680-OP transport package. The current CoC expires on October 31, 2020. The applicant requested to extend the expiration date of the CoC to January 31, 2021, to allow customers returning these packages for source disposition. The application also notes that the applicant would not be seeking a five-year renewal of CoC No. 9035. The applicant did not request changes to the package design or its authorized contents. The certificate has been extended until January 31, 2021. The Model No. 680-OP is under the applicant's quality assurance program with Docket No. 71-40 (ADAMS Accession Nos. ML15226A231 and ML17171A347).

EVALUATION

The staff reviewed the applicant's request to extend the expiration date of the CoC for the Model No. 680-OP and the documents referenced in the CoC and determined that the documentation was available and complete. The applicant is not requesting changes to the design or approved contents of the package.

Based on the application, the staff finds that the information provided by the applicant is adequate and the package continues to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.

CONDITIONS

The following conditions of the CoC were revised or added to the certificate:

- 1) In Condition No. 1.b., the revision No. of the certificate was increased to 24.
- 2) Condition No. 12 was deleted because the certificate will not be renewed, and it is not needed.
- 3) Condition No. 13 was renumbered as Condition No. 12 and revised to an expiration date of January 31, 2020.

The "REFERENCES" section of the CoC has been updated to include the date of the application requesting the extension of expiration date.

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been extended until January 31, 2021. Based on the statements contained in the application and the conditions listed above, the staff concludes that extending the expiration date of the certificate does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
