Good morning Ms. Kritzman,

I have reviewed the licensee's request dated May 1, 2020 to name you as the new Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) on the subject license. Based on the guidance in NUREG 1556, Volume 9, Revision 3, please provide the following information in a signed and dated letter (also co-signed my management):

1. Because you are named as the Radiation Safety Officer on a number of NRC licenses, please describe how you will allocate time to permit the performance of the duties of the RSO as described in the regulations. Please provide the minimum amount of onsite time (hours per week or days per quarter, as appropriate for the program);
2. Identify an in-house representative who will serve as the point of contact during your absence;
3. Describe your overall availability to respond to questions or operational issues that arise during the conduct of the radiation safety program and related regulatory requirements;
4. Specify the maximum amount of time it will take you to arrive at the facility in the event of an emergency that requires your presence.

Please provide your response in a signed and dated letter by June 11, 2020. You may submit the response directly to me via email.
