This letter supplements the request dated February 3, 1999 of Boston Edison Company ("Boston Edison"), that the Commission consent to the indirect transfer of control of Boston Edison's interest in Operating License No. DPR-35 (the "Pilgrim Operating License") pursuant to Section 184 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the "Act"), and 10 CFR §50.80. That request described the proposed merger (the "Parent Merger") of BEC Energy ("BEC"), the parent organization of Boston Edison, with Commonwealth Energy System ("COM/Energy").
