This acknowledges receipt of your letter of May 13, 1986.

Violation 1 - 4. Exam Company has increased its internal inspection looking for any unusual items that would indicate employee misunderstanding or violation of company procedures. Unannounced site inspections have been documented and retained in the employee's personnel file, in addition to the inspections which are executed within the 30 day regulatory limits. Greater emphasis has been placed on employee understanding of company procedures through reviewing completely the contents of the company's Operating and Emergency Manual at the time of hire. After discussing procedures, employee indicates his complete understanding by executing documentation signifying his knowledge.
