actions to represent a continuation of the investigation
#05-001-83(966).
I am not personally aware of our Waterford 3 management or super-
visory personnel advising Reactor Operators to not cooperate with the
Corporate Security Department investigators. I would not condone that
type of activity.
I would also like to point out that there is no reason which
would preclude the Corporate Security Department investigators from
conducting further investigation of this matter.
As a general comment, I would like re emphasize that it is the
policy of this company that we do not condone drug use on or off the
Waterford 3 site by our employees. Furthermore, I don't want this
report to represent an impression that our Corporate Security Depart-
ment investigators have been handcuffed in their activities at Water-
ford 3. We will make every effort to insure that drug matters are
adequately resolved.
With respect to Mr. Herr's request for a copy of the investiga-
rive report #05-001-83(966), based on the advice of my legal counsel,
