I, James M. Cain, hereby make the following voluntary statement to Donald D. Driskill, who has identified himself to me as an Investigator with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. I make this statement freely with no threats or promises of reward having been made to me.

I am the Chief Executive Officer of Louisiana Power & Light Company (LP&L), New Orleans, Louisiana, and have held this position since May 1983. This statement concerns LP&L's policy regarding drug use by LP&L employees, specifically Waterford 3 Nuclear Reactor Operators.

It is LP&L policy that drug use is not condoned by any LP&L employee either on or off duty.

I am not familiar with the specific details of our written company policy, such as the date of implementation and the extent to which it addresses drug and/or alcohol use. I will provide a copy of our drug/alcohol use policy to the NRC.

With respect to the LP&L Corporate Security Department investigation report number 5-001-83(966) relating to drug usage by Waterford 3 Reactor Operators, no one advised me of this particular investigation which was conducted during 1983. Today, November 20, 1984, is the first time I have seen that report. On this date, prior to meeting with NRC OI investigators, I was verbally briefed for the first time concerning this report and subsequent LP&L management actions. I have reviewed this report briefly and I am not in a position to discuss it in detail at this time. I would like to clarify the impression this report may give that the investigation was not completed. As reflected in the report documentation, the summary portion of this report does not represent LP&L's position regarding this matter in that further action was taken. As I have been advised by the Plant Manager, these actions consisted of lectures

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by Waterford 3 project management personnel to company employees, regarding LP&L's drug policy, as stated above, searches (including the use of dog searches), and use of random urinalysis. I interpret these actions to represent a continuation of the investigation #05-001-83(966).

I am not personally aware of our Waterford 3 management or supervisory personnel advising Reactor Operators to not cooperate with the Corporate Security Department investigators. I would not condone that type of activity.

I would also like to point out that there is no reason which would preclude the Corporate Security Department investigators from conducting further investigation of this matter.

As a general comment, I would like ^{to} re-emphasize that it is the policy of this company that we do not condone drug use on or off the Waterford 3 site by our employees. Furthermore, I don't want this report to represent an impression that our Corporate Security Department investigators have been handcuffed in their activities at Waterford 3. We will make every effort to insure that drug matters are adequately resolved.

With respect to Mr. Herr's request for a copy of the investigative report #05-001-83(966), based on the advice of my legal counsel, I will provide the NRC access to the investigative report, but will

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not provide a copy of the report to the NRC, due to the potential for
its public disclosure via a Freedom of Information Act request of
confidential information contained within the report.
