On May 4 - 7, 1999, the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted an announced inspection of the University of Arizona's Nuclear Reactor Laboratory TRIGA Reactor. The enclosed report presents the results of that inspection.

Various aspects of your reactor health physics, emergency preparedness, and safeguards programs were inspected, including selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations of the facility.

Based on the results of this inspection, no safety concern or noncompliance with NRC requirements was identified. No response to this letter is required.
