Dear Mr. Davis:

This letter is in response to the inspection conducted by Messrs. J.E. House and M.C. Schumacher on March 20, 1988, of Rad-Chem activities at LaSalle County Station. Reference (a) reported the results of that inspection in which no violations were identified. Commonwealth Edison would like to provide a minor clarification to the wording of a statement made in the second paragraph on Page 4 of the report to prevent possible future misunderstanding.

The existing line in the report reads, "The licensee stated that equipment for continuous data recording from the in-line monitors has been acquired and will be installed during the next outage." A more accurate representation of what was meant to be conveyed is, "Equipment for continuous data recording from the in-line monitors has been acquired and will be installed as part of the modification to install new sample panels. These modifications are currently scheduled to be completed during the third refueling outage on each unit."
