On or about August 28, 1998, the Applicant amended its license application to account for a new transportation corridor and a change in the location of the Rowley Junction intermodal transfer facility. On November 2, 1998, the OGD filed Contentions Q through Z. On November 3, 1998, the Board issued an Order requiring that responses to OGD's contentions be filed by November 12, 1998. The NRC Staff and the Applicant filed responses to OGD's Contentions on November 10 and 12, 1998, respectively.

Pursuant to Board's Memorandum and Order of February 2, 1998 (Memorializing Initial Prehearing Conference Directives), OGD requests leave to reply to the Staff's and Applicant's responses. According to the Board's Order, a reply from OGD would be due within ten days of the date the Staff and

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Applicant filed their responses (*i.e.*, on or before Monday, November 23, 1998). Order at 4, n. 3. OGD intends to limit its reply to each party to ten pages or less.

Counsel for the Staff and counsel for the Applicant do not oppose the Motion.

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
