Additionally, you should consult the American National Standard Inc., standard entitled SAFE DESIGN AND USE OF PANORAMIC, WET-SOURCE STORAGE GAMMA IRRADIATORS (CATEGORY IV) dated July 1984.

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 60 calendar days from the date of this letter. Should you need additional time, you need only notify us in writing.
