You will be periodically inspected by NRC. A fee may be charged for inspections in accordance with 10 CFR Part 170. This could include issuance of a notice of violation; imposition of a civil penalty; or an order suspending, modifying, or revoking your license as specified in the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Action, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C.
