## NRC STAFF'S NINTH PROGRESS REPORT AND ANNOTATED BIBLIOGRAPHY

#### 1. PROGRESS REPORT

This progress report is prepared in response to the Licensing Board's "Memorandum and Order (Progress Report and Notice of Available Documents)" dated June 6, 1986, and covers the period November 1, 1987 through December 31, 1987.

1. Discovery

There has been no change in the status of discovery during this reporting period. However, in a letter dated December 2, 1987 to the Citizens Association for Sound Energy (CASE's) counsel, the Staff set forth its intentions regarding how it will make documents available to the parties in the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station (CPSES) operating license proceedings once the Staff issues a Supplemental Safety Evaluation on a given Applicant Project Status Report (PSR). On December 9, 1987, CASE counsel responded advising that the Staff's intentions do not solve the problem of CASE accessing documents.

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### 2. Construction Permits

The Applicants' April 29, 1987 request for an extension of the latest construction completion date of Construction Permit CPPR-127 for CPSES, Unit 2, is still under Staff consideration. On December 12, 1987, the Applicants responded to the Staff's October 23, 1987 request for additional information regarding local wells, Texas Water Development Board observation wells, and geologic features in the vicinity of the plant site. The staff requested this information in order to complete its evaluation of the effects of continued groundwater withdrawal for CPSES construction. Groundwater withdrawal for construction in the construction permit, as amended.

#### 3. Operating Licenses

On November 2-3, 1987, representatives of the Comanche Peak Project Division, along with the Director and Deputy Director of the Office of Special Projects, attended the prehearing conference conducted by the Board to discuss alternative scheduling approaches with the parties for litigation of matters that remain to be resolved under Contention 5. On November 9, 1987 the Staff provided comments to the Board on the schedule proposed by the Board during the prehearing conference. The Board issued a Memorandum and Order on November 18, 1987 to establish the litigation schedule governing discovery and the resolution of issues in the CPSES case.

During this reporting period, the Staff received Applicants' submittal of 5 Project Status Reports (PSRs) (large bore piping and pipe supports, small bore piping and pipe supports, cable tray and cable tray hangers, Train C conduit supports  $\leq$  2" in diameter, and Trains A and E and Train.C conduit

supports > 2" in diameter) and the Collective Evaluation Report. This constitutes 6 of the 13 Applicant documents around which the litigation schedule is organized, as ordered by the Board.

### 4. Staff Review and Efforts

During this reporting period, the Staff continued to review the Applicants' corrective action efforts and began work on an evaluation of their programs. On November 13, 1987, the Staff requested CASE to provide specific comments and concerns on the Applicants' corrective action efforts so that the comments and concerns could be considered during development of the Staff's evaluation. The Staff conducted a public meeting on December 9, 1987 to discuss the status of the Applicants' corrective action efforts, including the Corrective Action Program (CAP) and the Comanche Peak Response team activities, and to obtain clarifications needed by the Staff in order to complete their evaluation of the Applicants' programs. CASE was given an opportunity at the meeting to provide comments for Staff consideration. The Staff is using the information obtained during this meeting and in a December 18, 1987 letter from Applicants responding to Staff comments during the meeting on the corrective action efforts, as well as clarifications on the CAP documented by Applicants in a November 25, 1987 letter to the Staff, to finalize the Staff evaluation. The evaluation stating the conditions for acceptability of the Applicants' corrective action programs, including a condition for approval by the Staff prior to implementation of any changes to the programs, is expected to be issued in the next reporting period.

On December 15, 1987 the Staff provided the Board and all parties in the CPSES proceedings its planning document which sets forth a schedule of Staff

activities for completing the CPSES licensing activities. This schedule is based on the Applicants' current fuel load readiness date of August 1988. Scheduled dates will be revised periodically as the Staff receives new information on the activities associated with the schedule.

Staff review and evaluation of licensing items is ongoing. On December 3, 1987, the Staff transmitted for Applicants' review a markup of the first draft Technical Specifications (TS) for CPSES, Unit 1. A meeting between the Staff and Applicants to discuss the first draft TS in detail was held January 11-15, 1988. On November 12, 1987, the Staff met with the Applicants to discuss an open Final Safety Analysis Report review item on the jet impingement effects in the break exclusion region of the main steam and feedwater piping at CPSES, Units 1 and 2. The Staff met with Applicants on December 16, 1987 to discuss the Applicants' plans to implement the new broadscope GDC 4 rule, which allows the use of advanced fracture mechanics analysis (leak-before-break technology) to preclude the need for dynamic effects of pipe ruptures in the plant design basis. Also discussed at this meeting was Stone and Webster Engineering Corporation's (SWEC's) efforts to validate the CPSES selsmic building response spectra.

The Staff attended a meeting between the Applicants and CASE which was a continuation of discussions on pipe supports started in March 1987. In addition to discussing piping and pipe support issues, the Applicants presented an overview of several CAP scopes of work and conducted a plant tour to show examples of hardware corrections currently under way.

The Staff continued its review of the Applicants' design validation activities associated with the CAP, completing the second design inspection of the mechanical, civil/structural, electrical, and instrumentation and control

design areas being reviewed by SWEC and Ebasco Services, Incorporated. The results of this design inspection will be documented in an inspection report which is expected to be issued during the next reporting period. A follow-up inspection to resolve open items from the two design inspections conducted thus far and to review the area of systems interaction is also scheculed to be conducted during the next reporting period. Following the issuance of the Applicants' PSRs in these CAP areas, the Staff expects to document its review in one or more safety evaluations. The Staff is concluding its review of the piping and pipe support issues and expects to issue a safety evaluation on these issues in early 1988. Further audits of the Applicants' design verification efforts in the areas of cable tray hangers, conduit supports, and heating ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) were conducted during this reporting period. The staff efforts will be documented in an inspection report which is expected to be issued during the next reporting period. Additional audits in the areas of cable tray hangers, conduit supports and HVAC will also be conducted in early 1988.

The NRC Comanche Peak Allegation Review Committee (ARC) met on November 19, 1987. The Committee discussed staff actions necessary to address 4 new allegations received during this reporting period. In addition, the ARC reviewed the status of past allegations and actions needed to close those that remain open.

### 5. Onsite Inspection Activities

The NRC onsite inspectors and consultants continued their safety inspections of the CAP, including Issue Specific Action Plans, the postconstruction hardware validation program, the Technical Audit Program,

construction work in progress, the preoperational test program, revisions to electric specifications, plant tours, and follow-up on previously identified NRC findings, allegations, 10 CFR 50.55(e) deficiency reports, and nonconformance reports. A total of 60 items requiring NRC follow-up inspection were closed in inspection reports of onsite activities issued during November and December 1987 and 31 new items requiring follow-up were opened.

During this reporting period the following inspection reports of onsite activities were issued:

The findings are discussed further in the following paragraphs and will be followed up by the NRC inspectors during the comings months:

Inspection Report 50-445/8718; 50-446/8714 documents four violations: а. (1) documents listed on the package inventory card not agreeing with the document package contents issued by the Paper Flow Group, (2) an engineering evaluation not being performed on an inaccessible weld attribute due to erroneous acceptance by a QC inspector, (3) a nonconformance report (NCR) not being issued for a failed capscrew on a pipe support, and (4) actions required in the disposition of an NCR not having been accomplished. The deviation concerns multiple errors in recording as-built information, such as dimensions, during a walkdown. The unresolved items involve the shimming of steam generator holddown bolts and two undocumented capacitors in the CPSES, Unit 1, diesel generator control panels. The latter item has been documented as a violation in Inspection Report 50-445/8730; 50-446/8722 (see The open items are related to tagging and control of paragraph 5.f). electrical work in progress, the use of problem identification sheets, deficiency reports not being issued when it appeared to be appropriate to do so, and a copy of an NCR dispositioned "use-as-is" not being provided to the NCR's originator.

b. Inspection Report 50-445/8724; 50-446/8718 documents one open item related to the generic applicability of an identified manufacturing defect in steel columns.

c. Inspection Report 50-445/8725; 50-446/8719 documents one unresolved item relating to an inspection attribute missing from the attribute matrix and two open items relating to multiple errors in recording as-built information during walkdowns.

d. Inspection Report 50-445/8727; 50-446/8720 documents three violations (inadequate design specification, failure to follow procedure, and inadequate

corrective action) which resulted in CPSES, Unit 1, auxiliary feedwater pump motors being installed with the motor fans backwards, the condition not having been identified when the motor power leads were reversed, and the condition in Unit 1 not being identified following the identification of the same problem in Unit 2.

e. Inspection Report 50-445/8729; 50-446/8721 documents one deviation, an example of an error in recording as-built information, and one open item relating to a missed inspection of an attribute.

f. Inspection Report 50-445/8730; 50-446/8722 documents two violations (failure to control modifications and failure to control drawings), both of which resulted from NRC follow-up on the two capacitors installed in the CPSES, Unit 1, diesel generator control panels (see 5.a). The five open items all relate to electrical issues: taped electrical joints, cable pulling lubricant, abandoned cable pulling aids, separation requirements, and electrical penetration assemblies in isolation valve tanks.

g. Inspection Report 50-445/8731; 50-446/8723 documents one violation and one deviation, both concerning multiple examples of errors in recording as-built information during walkdowns. The second violation concerns examples of improper closeout of NCRs. The unresolved item involves inconsistencies of dates in a calculation package (the summary of loads and checking the calculations dated prior to the date of some other calculations.

These inspection reports were issued within an average of 16 days after the end of the inspection period.

The fire protection team inspection which was performed October 19-23, 1987 was documented in Inspection Report 50-445/8722 issued on January 12, 1988.

An enforcement conference was held on December 8, 1987 to discuss the auxiliary feedwater pump motor fans being installed backwards in relationship to the desired direction of motor rotation. This event was considered significant because over a period of years, the Applicants had several chances to prevent, identify, and/or correct the condition but did not. The event had minor safety significance and was therefore not considered for escalated enforcement action.

## 6. Other

The Staff has informed the Applicants that a Systematic Assessment of License Performance (SALP) evaluation for the CPSES will be conducted in the fall of 1988. For planning purposes, the evaluation period begins on September 1, 1987 and will end on August 31, 1988. The exact date may be affected, however, by the status of licensing activities for the plant in August 1988.

On November 17, 1987, "Director's Decision Under 10 CFR 2.206" (DD-87-17), which was issued on October 16, 1987, became final agency action as the time provided by NRC regulations within which the Commission may act to review the Decision expired and the Commission declined any review. DD-87-17 responded to a Petition filed with the NRC in March 1984 by the Government Accountability Project on behalf of CASE and several CPSES nuclear workers. The Petition requested NRC to take certain actions with respect to alleged serious construction and documentation deficiencies at CPSES. The Staff granted the Petitioners' request for special NRC inspections at the CPSES and denied the request to suspend construction activities and to

direct the Applicants to initiate an independent design and construction verification program and management audits at the CPSES.

During this reporting period the Staff completed 8 Freedom of Information Act requests related to CPSES received during November and December 1987,  $\frac{1}{}$  and received 6 new requests for action. Approximately 34 Staff hours were expended in searching and preparing the responses for the 7 completed record searches.

#### ANNOTATED BIBLIOGRAPHY

The attached annotated bibliography is a computer-generated report prepared from the NRC's document control system. It contains separate lists of all documents originated by NRC that have been sent to the Applicants and to Intervenors relating to the Comanche Peak Project that were indexed during the period November 1, 1987 through December 31, 1987.

As explained in the Staff's First Progress Report, the listing of any particular document does not constitute a determination by the Staff of the document's relevance to either the OL proceeding or the CP extension proceeding.
