DEAR SECRETARY OF THE COMMISSION:

I UNDERSTAND THAT YOU ARE CURRENTLY ACCEPTING COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC ON PROPOSED RULE CHANGES CLARIFICATIONS REGARDING LOW POWER LICENSING OF NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS.

I HAVE LIVED ALL MY LIFE IN NEW ENGLAND, AND MY SPECIAL CONCERNS ARE ABOUT SEABROOK STATION. I AM AN AVID OUTDOORSMAN AND HAVE SEEN FIRST HAND THE DAMAGE ACID RAIN CAN CAUSE. I THINK IT IS CRITICAL THAT SEABROOK STATION IS LICENSED FOR FULL POWER OPERATION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE FOR THE FUTURE OF NEW ENGLAND'S ENVIRONMENT AS WELL AS ENERGY NEEDS.

I ALSO BELIEVE IN DUE PROCESS OF LAW, BUT I THINK THE INTERVENORS TO THE OPERATION OF SEABROOK STATION HAVE CARRIED DUE PROCESS BEYOND LIMITS. I FEEL IF MASS DOES NOT WANT WARNING SIRENS THAT'S THEIR BUSINESS. THEY HAD THEIR CHANCE TO UTILIZE THE WARNING DEVICES WHEN THEY WERE INSTALLED. I DO NOT THINK IT IS FAIR TO OTHER RESIDENTS OF NEW ENGLAND, FOR MASS TO FURTHER SLOW DOWN SEABROOK OPERATION BY OBJECTING TO NOT HAVING WARNING SIRENS INSTALLED WHEN IT WAS THE SAME PEOPLE THAT ORDERED THEM REMOVED.

I SUPPORT ANY MODIFICATIONS TO EXISTING RULES OR REGULATIONS THAT COULD ELIMINATE LOCAL POLITICAL ORGANIZATIONS OR INDIVIDUAL POLITICIANS FROM SLOWING DOWN THE OPERATION OF SEABROOK STATION
