To whom it may concern:

I am writing this letter to reinforce the broad public support behind the proposed rule change which would allow Seabrook Station, or any other power plant, to complete low power testing without an emergency notification system in place.

As you know the area surrounding Seabrook, N.H., specifically the Massachusetts communities within the ten mile radius, had in place a siren notification system to be used in case of emergencies, Not just radiological emergencies but any other emergency, be it floods, chemical or fire. The public officials behind the removal of these sirens are clearly placing the safety of their constituents in unnecessary jeopardy and I for one am outraged. However, the New Hampshire Yankee organization has detailed a plan to compensate for gross mismanagement, by the Governor, Attorney General and others from Massachusetts. Proving once again that "where there is a will, there is a way"

I hope that those of you in the NRC with the expertise and experience required to evaluate and approve the conditions required for a low power and full power operating licence will clear the path of the unscrupulous intervenors and allow these power plants to operate, or at a minimum perform low power testing.

For the sake of the future needs of this region, and the energy needs of the country, approve this rule change.
