We are trying to transfer or dispose of the Irradiator along with the Cesium 137. We are networking through North American Scientific and will begin to network through the Radioactive Waste & Broker Processor Service, of which we have a list given to us by James Bondick of your office, and will contact the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection if needed. We would hope to transfer or dispose of the Irradiator and Cesium 137 within six months using the following plans:

- Plan A: Transfer or dispose of the Irradiator and Cesium 137
- Plan B: Transfer or dispose of the Cesium 137

Plan C: Transfer or dispose of the Irradiator

We will put major effort in utilizing Plan A, in order to comply with NRC Region 1 concerns.
