

Dear Mr. Cain.

In response to the request made by Mr. Brown and yourself during our teleconference of October 2, 1987, I am providing written confirmation that none of the individuals involved with the radiological program conducted by the former Western Stress, Inc. will be affected by the Radioactive Materials License currently under consideration. There are no individuals that were involved in the Evanston, Wyoming incident, or with the former Radiology Program, involved with Western Stress, Inc.'s current radiological control program.

Western Stress, Inc. and its management are arduously concerned with occupational and radiological safety in the work place. In its commitment to safety in the work place, Western Stress, Inc. has made tremendous capital equipment investments in order to provide its personnel with the safest, state of the art equipment available in todays industry. With respect to safety equipment, contingencies have been provided in every case. For example, field units are provided with a minimum of two, and usually three survey instruments, all personnel are required to wear two direct reading pocket dosimeters and thermoluminescent dosimetry rather than film badges are utilized. I believe that these equipment considerations, combined with the training and experience of our personnel, our own internal training and retraining programs, and the application of continuously updated detailed procedures indicates a substantial effort on the part of Western Stress, Inc. to provide for the health and welfare of its employees and the general public.
