



As I mentioned during our telephone conversation, Western Stress, Inc. is currently conducting radiographic operations from three (3) of its fifteen district facilities under agreement program licenses, with a fourth to begin shortly. Approval of this application will permit initiaion of operations at two of our facilities located in NRC jurisdiction. Each location equipped with permanent storage facilities is staffed with a qualified resident District Radiation Safety Officer and radiation safety records pertaining to operations conducted out of that location are maintained at that facility for inspection.
