Dear Sirs:

I am writing in favor of the NRC rule clarification concerning 5% testing of Seabrook without off-site emergency sirens. I believe that the minimal risks associated with this testing negates the need for a prompt notification system.

In addition the sham concocted by the State of Massachusetts to remove sirens placed in that state, and then to use the lack of them as justification not to issue a license is a travesty. This state of affairs dramatically highlights the intricate conspiratorial web fabricated by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and the inability of a bureaucratic regulatory agency to deal with an aberration of the licensing process.

In a more rational world, a state which abrogates its responsibility to participate in emergency planning should not be allowed to stall licensing. The current licensing process has effectively been used by rabid anti-nukes to "cut the throat" of the nuclear industry. All we are doing now is talking about how to revive a carcass.
