
Dear Secretary,

I am writing in support of your proposed rules change which would allow 5% testing at nuclear power plants without having full-scale evacuation plans in place. I think that the change should be adopted as soon as possible to prevent the obstructionist tactics of Massachusetts politicians from stalling a much needed power plant.

The transmission of power is interstate commerce and is clearly under Federal jurisdiction.
