Gentlemen:

As a 51-year resident, born, raised, and living in New England, I strongly urge the Commission to proceed to adopt its proposed clarification of emergency planning requirements for low-power licenses. Also to make clear that off-site emergency sirens are not required during low-power testing.

Nuclear power is a needed resource with far less environmental impact than alternate methods such as fossil fuels.

Please take a good, hard look at what you have done concerning nuclear power in general and simplify the licensing process. This is done with a one-stop process, in which you have spelled out objectives to be attained (not every little detail in how to obtain the objectives) and a review and monitoring by staff to ensure that they believe that the objectives will, in fact, be attained.
