It has been brought to my attention that the US. Nuclear Regulatory Commission is relaxing its regulations of worker and environmental radiation exposure levels. We, the public, are becoming increasingly aware of the danger of radioactivity and we are alarmed at the way in which governmental agencies who are supposed to be protecting us from health dangers are instead protecting the economic interests of the nuclear industry.

It is my belief that no new NRC rule on radiation standards should be passed unless exposures are reduced or eliminated. It is imperative that an environmental impact statement be done on this rule Part II Title 10 CFR Parts 19 et al. Also, a public hearing should be held.

The public is tired of having wool pulled over its eyes. We won't stand for profit at the expense of public health any longer. We are losing faith in the governmental agencies that claim to be protecting us.
