Dear Mr. Cain:

Enclosed, in accordance with your request of July 27, 1987, is the revised application for renewal of the subject license which expired February 26, 1986. The application submitted to your office January 27, 1986, has been revised to incorporate the requirements of the recently promulgated 10 CFR 39.

A noteworthy change in the current license is the omission of the Sr-90 and Cadmium-109 sources. The Sr-90 sources were of an exempt quantity when purchased in 1974, and a current inventory shows they have since decayed to approximately 80% of the original activity. The Cadmium source was purchased in 1971 and has decayed from 5 mCi to an exempt quantity (<2 uCi).

The required renewal fee was submitted to your office with the application submitted January 27, 1986.
