Western Nuclear, Inc. - January 25, 1968

In the Riverton Ranger of January 19, 1968, Mr. Johnson said that a suit had been filed against Western-Nuclear for damages by six ranchers adjacent to the Susquehanna-Western uranium mill. The damage claimed is for air pollution from the sulfuric acid plant owned by Western Nuclear and formerly owned by Susquehanna-Western. Three hundred thousand dollars in damages are claimed. Mr. Johnson also said that Susquehanna-Western is being sued for approximately one million dollars by the same ranchers for damages resulting from water pollution due to seepage from the tailings pond located at the Susquehanna mill. This mill has not been in operation since the fall of 1963.

The ore dryer installed in December 1967 for drying the Golden Goose ore has proven entirely inadequate for the job. The installed dryer was designed to dry sand and gravel at the rate of 300 tons per hour. The Golden Goose ore contains a large amount of clay which chokes up both the feed end and discharge end of the kiln. An average of 5-600 tons of ore from the Golden Goose are dried daily in a one shift operation. The 6-700 tons more needed for the daily millfeed is obtained by drying Wyoming Continental ore from mill stockpiles in a second shift operation.

Western Nuclear has ordered another dryer to replace the one in use. The new dryer will be installed at the mine. It will be necessary to install a two mile pipeline to bring sufficient gas to the dryer from the main gas line.

It was said the water consumption at the mill is 2 1/2-3 tons of water per ton of ore processed. No reclaimed water from the tailings pond is being returned to the mill.

VanB note of 3/3/68

The referenced Susquehanna-Western uranium mill is located near Riverton, Wyoming. It started operations in _____ and closed in April 1963, leaving an accumulation of some 900,000 tons of tailings, uncovered on the site. On this same site Susquehanna built a sulfuric acid plant to serve its own needs, and to some extent those of other mills. The acid plant was continued in commercial operation after the uranium mill was closed in 1963, but was finally sold to Western Nuclear in December 1966.

The Western Nuclear uranium mill together with another acid plant are located some 40 miles southeast of Riverton at Jeffrey City. Both are still operating.
