The enclosed document was produced in mid-1979 as a basis for Conoco's on site monitoring requirements. Since that time numerous changes have taken place which require that the document be extensively revised in the future:

1. The description of the project area presented here is invalid due to the current planning involving mining and tailing management systems.
2. TERA Corporation is no longer under contract with Conoco to perform the audits described in this document.
3. Conoco has recently replaced the on site meteorological equipment. Met One and Datel equipment have been replaced with systems manufactured by the Climatronics Corporation.
4. Conoco is currently in the process of developing in-house capability for all data processing functions of meteorological data.
5. PSD regulations have changed since the production of this monitoring plan.

The format and intent of the monitoring plan is however sound, and we will be using this as a model for future revisions which will accurately describe the current situation on the project site.
