In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p) changes to the security training program at the Trojan Nuclear Plant, as described in the Security Force Training and Qualification Plan, PGE-1024, have been implemented. Our evaluation has determined that these changes do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the security program. Briefly, the changes add the position of Operations Clerk and its associated responsibilities involving card key enrollment.

Attachment 1 is a detailed description of the changes, along with a discussion of the reasons for making the changes. Attachment 2 consists of five copies of the replacement pages for the Trojan Security Plan. Another copy is being forwarded to the Director of Nuclear Reactor Regulation.



In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p), the following changes to the Security Force Training and Qualification Plan (PGE-1024) have been implemented. These changes are considered minor in nature and do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the training program.

Description of Changes

- Table 2-1.1, SHIFT ASSIGNMENTS - The "Operations Clerk" position is added under Security Personnel.
- Table 2-2.1, Page 2 of 7, Individual Responsibility Matrix - The "Operations Clerk" position is added to the shift assignment section. Individual Responsibilities 2.13, 2.14, and 2.15 are added to the matrix section.
- Table 2-3.1, Page 2 of 18, Security Watch Supervisor, Job Analysis Work Sheet - Individual Responsibility Matrix Items 2.13, 2.14, and 2.15 are added under the "Conditions" column of Matrix Item 2.0.
- Table 2-3.1, Page 3 of 18, Security Watch Supervisor, Job Analysis Work Sheet - Individual Responsibility Matrix Items 2.13, 2.14, and 2.15 as described in Insert 1 are added to the work sheet.
- Table 2-3.2, Page 2 of 7, Security Officer 1 and 2, Central/Secondary Alarm Station Operators, Job Analysis Work Sheet - Individual Responsibility Matrix Items 2.14 and 2.15 as described in Insert 1 are added to the work sheet.
- Table 2-3.3, Pages 1 and 4, Plant Shift Supervisor; Security Officer 3, Guardhouse Access Control, Job Analysis Work Sheet - The "Operations Clerk" position is added to the Shift Assignment titles.
- Table 2-3.3, Page 4 of 10, Plant Shift Supervisor; Security Officer 3, Guardhouse Access Control, Job Analysis Work Sheet - Individual responsibility Matrix Items 2.13, 2.14, and 2.15 as described in Insert 1 are added to the work sheet.
