Investigation of Concern Letter to the NRC dated March 25, 1986

Dear Mr. Keppler:

Illinois Power Company (IP) received a copy of the subject letter concerning the competency of an IP supervisor. IP has investigated this concern. The results of this investigation are stated below:

- Qualifications of the supervisor in question were reviewed by the department manager and IP Human Resources. Both reviews concluded that, based on experience and education, the supervisor is qualified to fulfill the assigned position.
- The concernee was interviewed by IP Quality Assurance and the department manager. In both interviews, the concernee stated that he knew of no quality or hardware problems that exist in the plant.

Based on the above, IP concludes that the supervisor in question is qualified to fulfill the assigned position. Investigation of this concern did not reveal any existing quality or hardware problems. Documentation supporting these conclusions is available on site for NRC review.
