Re: Export License 37-30-3 (G60)

We have received order from Wheeler Airlines for the procurement of tritium activated emergency exit signs which will involve the transportation of 142 curies of tritium. Wheeler has secured Canadian AEC license #7506 covering their possession of the material under Canadian law. In accordance with your conversation with Mr. Dooley this afternoon, we are asking that you amend our license to permit the shipment of up to 200 curies to any one foreign customer. It is Mr. Dooley's impression that you will be able to expedite this amendment for us to enable us to meet our promised delivery date.

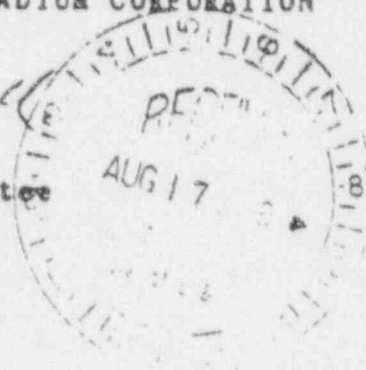
