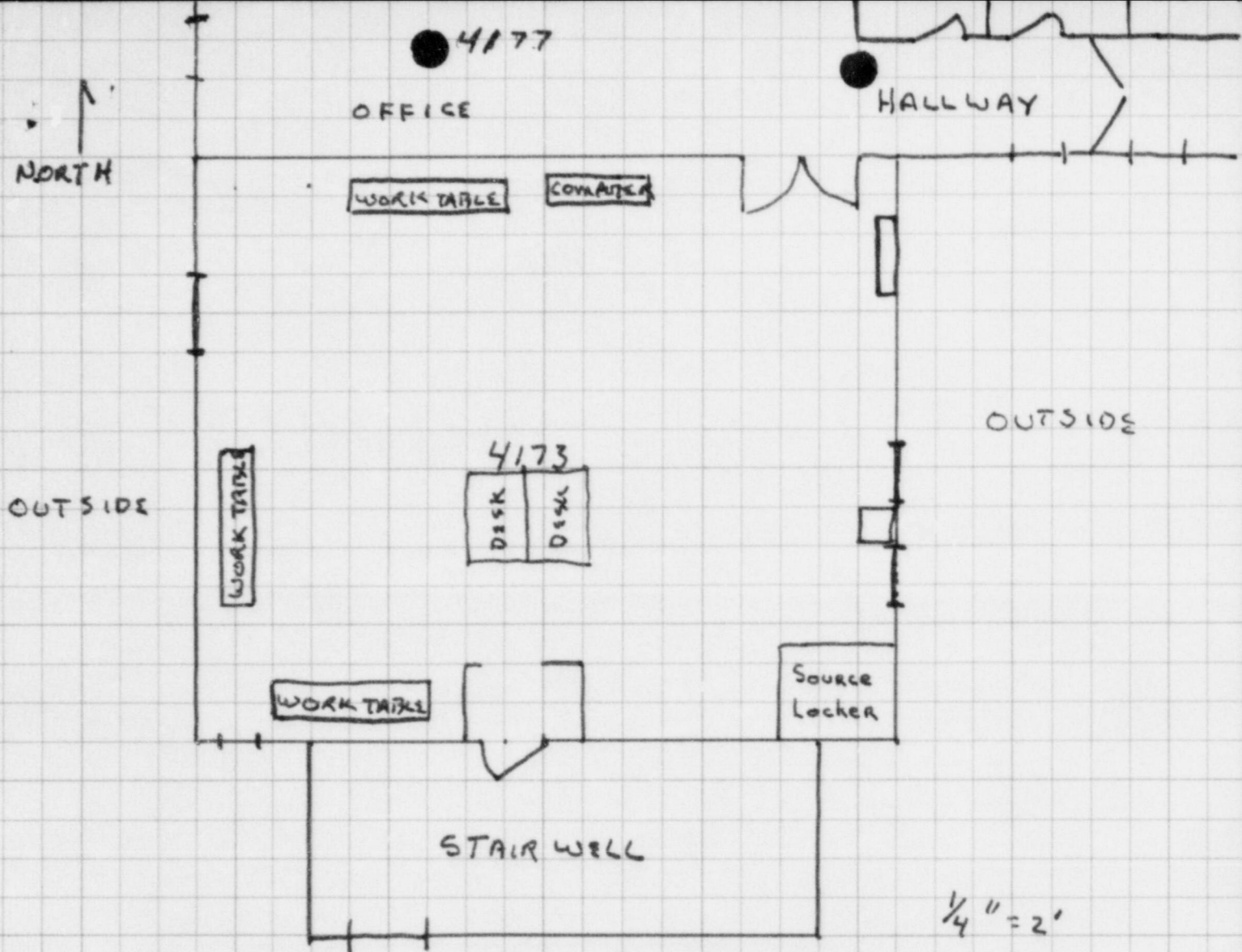


DIAGRAM OF FOURTH FLOOR BLDG 4/6
